MEMBERSHIP NOTES:

- Meetings are usually every two weeks after school from 3-5p.m.
- Membership is open to all students, all grades.
- There are no elected officers, instead leaders rise to the top according to each student's gifts, interest and time available for each specific activity.
- Therefore, students can come and be part of us at any time throughout the school year according to sports and other co-curricular activities.

The only requirements are that the student is academically eligible and interested in being part of a dynamic group of students who challenge, empower and hold each other accountable in making a difference in the school and broader communities.

PROJECTS: Plan, implement and support retreats and liturgies; Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper and other events as needed.
