

**DRESS UP AND DRESS DOWN DAYS
REVISED 2009**

DRESSING UP:

ATTIRE MUST BE EQUAL TO OR BETTER THAN THE UNIFORM

Girls - Should wear dresses, skirts, Capri pants or slacks, shoulders covered at all times, and dress shoes.

GIRLS MAY NOT WEAR bare midriffs, tank tops, spaghetti straps or strapless tops or dresses, short skirts or shorts, tight clothing, jeans of any kind, flip flops, or any body piercing (except earrings), tattoos

Boys - Should wear golf or dress shirts with pants; dress shoes with backs.

BOYS MAY NOT WEAR muscle shirts, tee shirts, jeans of any kind, flip flops, athletic shoes, boots or athletic shoes, any body piercing or tattoos

DRESSING DOWN DAYS AND SCHOOL SPONSORED EVENTS:

Attire can be more relaxed, but must demonstrate modest appearance at all times. Jeans, shorts, sweat pants, athletic shoes, boots and flip-flops may be worn.

GIRLS MAY NOT WEAR bare midriffs, tank tops, spaghetti straps or strapless tops or dresses, short skirts or shorts, tight clothing, shirts or tops with inappropriate sayings or any body piercing (except earrings on girls), tattoos

Dress out days are a privilege. Failure to comply with the dress code may result in loss of the privilege. If the attire is inappropriate, parents may be called to bring a change of clothing to school. Students may be asked to leave a school-sponsored event if dress is immodest.
